

Notice of Public Hearing

Notice is hereby given that the Siskiyou County Local Transportation Commission (SCLTC) will hold a Public Hearing on Tuesday, June 9, 2026, at 9:00 a.m., or as soon thereafter as the matter may be heard, in the Siskiyou County Transit Center Conference Room, 190 Greenhorn Road, Yreka, California, on the item described below.

Participation in this meeting will be available via Zoom/teleconference. The information necessary to participate via Zoom/teleconference will be set forth on the meeting agenda the Friday before the meeting. Should you wish to comment on this project, you may submit a written comment or attend in person.

Siskiyou County Evacuation and Preparedness Plan

The proposed item encompasses the entire region (County of Siskiyou). The SCLTC will receive a presentation from consultants regarding the Siskiyou County Evacuation and Preparedness Plan and consider potential adoption of the Plan. The purpose of the hearing is to review the Plan, receive public comment, and consider whether to adopt the Plan or provide direction to staff and consultants regarding revisions.

Environmental Review (CEQA)

It is anticipated that the proposed action will be determined not to be a project pursuant to the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Guidelines Section 15378(b)(4), as it involves organizational and administrative activities of government that will not result in a direct or indirect physical change in the environment.

Documents related to this item are available for public review at the Siskiyou County Transit Center, 190 Greenhorn Road, Yreka, California, 96097, Monday through Friday between 8 a.m. and 12 p.m. or 1 p.m. and 5 p.m., excluding County holidays. Project documents will also be available on the Commission's website at <https://siskiyoucoltc.org> and will be posted with the meeting agenda prior to the hearing.

All items presented to the Transportation Commission during a public hearing, including but not limited to, letters, e-mails, petitions, photos, or maps, become a permanent part of the record and must be submitted to the Clerk of the Commission. It is advised that the presenter bring 10 copies of anything presented to the Commission and that the presenter create copies in advance for their own records.

All public records related to an open session item on the Agenda which are not exempt from disclosure pursuant to the California Public Records Act that are distributed to a majority of the legislative body will be available for public inspection at 190 Greenhorn Road, Yreka, CA 96097, at the time that the public records are distributed or made available to a majority of the members of the legislative body.

Any concerns or issues relating to the project must be raised during the public review period or at the public hearing. Public comments can be submitted via mail or hand delivery to the Transportation Commission (190 Greenhorn Road, Yreka, CA 96097) or email to general@co.siskiyou.ca.us. Please include your name and physical address.

Comments must be received by the Commission by 5:00 p.m. the day before the public hearing. If you challenge either the proposed project or the project's environmental document in court, you may

be limited to raising only those issues you or someone else raised at the public hearing described in this notice, or in written correspondence delivered to the Transportation Commission prior to or at the public hearing.
